1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in June 2012: 18,691,000 b/d (June 2011: 19,277,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in June 2012: 10,926,000 barrels per day (June 2011: 11,619,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in June 2012 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 58.5 percent (June 2011: 60.3 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in April 2012 as a percentage of total imports: 30.0 percent (April 2011: 19.3 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for June 2012: \$93.98 per barrel. [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in May 2012 for a barrel of crude oil: \$102.61 per barrel. [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in June 2012: 6,197,000 b/d (of which 517,000 b/d was Alaskan) (June 2011: 5,598,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in June 2012: 2,380,000 b/d (June 2011: 2,176,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in April 2012: 69.3 billion cubic feet per day (April 2011: 66.0 billion cf/d). [DOE]
