

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE - January 2014 release

- 1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in January 2014: 19,201,000 b/d (January 2013: 18,646,000 b/d). [API]
- 2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in January 2014: 9,252,000 barrels per day (January 2013: 10,042,000 b/d). [API]
- 3. Total imports in January 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 48.2 percent (January 2013: 53.9 percent). [API]
- 4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in November 2013 as a percentage of total imports: 39.7 percent (November 2012: 31.3 percent). [DOE]
- 5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for January 2014: \$104.71 per barrel. (January 2013: \$109.28 per barrel). [OPEC]
- 6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in December 2013 for a barrel of crude oil: \$93.64 per barrel. (December 2012: \$95.06 per barrel) [DOE]
- 7. U.S. crude oil production in January 2014: 8,089,000 b/d (of which 561,000 b/d was Alaskan) (January 2013: 7,030,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in January 2014: 2,752,000 b/d (January 2013: 2,361,000 b/d). [API]
- 8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in November 2013: 72.1 billion cubic feet per day (November 2012: 70.2 billion cf/d). [DOE]
- 9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in January 2014: 8,308,000 b/d (January 2013: 8,218,000 b/d). [API]
- 10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in January 2014: 4,074,000 b/d (January 2013: 4,055,000 b/d). [API]
- 11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in January 2014: 1,769, down from December 2013 at 1,771 but was up from January 2013's count of 1,756 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
