

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE –JULY 2016 release

1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2016: 20,141,000 b/d (July 2015: 19,979,000 b/d). [API]

2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in July 2016: 10,453,000 barrels per day (July 2015: 9,511,000 b/d). [API]

3. Total imports in July 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 51.9 percent (July 2015: 47.6 percent). [API]

4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in May 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 42.5 percent (May 2015: 37.5 percent). [DOE]

5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for July 2016: \$42.68 per barrel. (July 2015: \$54.19 per barrel). [OPEC]

6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in June 2016 for a barrel of crude oil: \$45.72 per barrel. (June 2015: \$60.12 per barrel) [DOE]

7. U.S. crude oil production in July 2016: 8,493,000 b/d (of which 474,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2015: 9,432,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2016: 3,571,000 b/d (July 2015: 3,284,000 b/d). [API]

8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in May 2016: 78.1 billion cubic feet per day (May 2015: 78.3 billion cf/d). [DOE]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in July 2016: 9,668,000 b/d (July 2015: 9,438,000 b/d). [API]

10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in July 2016: 3,758,000 b/d (July 2015: 3,877,000 b/d). [API]

11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in July 2016 was 450–fourth lowest count on record (all-time high of 4,530 announced November 1981; record low of 409 announced May 2016). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
