

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – JANUARY 2016 release

1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in January 2016: 19,393,000 b/d (January 2015: 19,249,000 b/d). [API]

2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in January 2016: 9,890,000 barrels per day (January 2015: 9,393,000 b/d). [API]

3. Total imports in January 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 50.9 percent (January 2015: 48.8 percent). [API]

4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in November 2015 as a percentage of total imports: 38.4 percent (November 2015: 34.3 percent). [DOE]

5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for January 2016: \$26.50 per barrel. (January 2015: \$44.38 per barrel). [OPEC]

6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in December 2015 for a barrel of crude oil: \$36.14 per barrel. (December 2014: \$60.57 per barrel) [DOE]

7. U.S. crude oil production in January 2016: 9,217,000 b/d (of which 570,000 b/d was Alaskan) (January 2015: 9,345,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in January 2016: 3,402,000 b/d (January 2015: 2,980,000 b/d). [API]

8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in November 2015: 79.2 billion cubic feet per day (November 2014: 77.5 billion cf/d). [DOE]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in January 2016: 8,839,000 b/d (January 2015: 8,718,000 b/d). [API]

10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in January 2016: 3,622,000 b/d (January 2015: 4,235,000 b/d). [API]

11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in January 2016 was 656 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
