

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE –JUNE 2016 release

1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in June 2016: 20,135,000 b/d (June 2015: 19,591,000 b/d). [API]

2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in June 2016: 9,784,000 barrels per day (June 2015: 9,552,000 b/d). [API]

3. Total imports in June 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 48.6 percent (June 2015: 48.8 percent). [API]

4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in April 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 36.5 percent (April 2015: 34.9 percent). [DOE]

5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for June 2016: \$45.84 per barrel. (June 2015: \$60.21 per barrel). [OPEC]

6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in May 2016 for a barrel of crude oil: \$43.58 per barrel. (May 2015: \$58.65 per barrel) [DOE]

7. U.S. crude oil production in June 2016: 8,624,000 b/d (of which 507,000 b/d was Alaskan) (June 2015: 9,315,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in June 2016: 3,482,000 b/d (June 2015: 3,259,000 b/d). [API]

8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in April 2016: 78.8 billion cubic feet per day (April 2015: 79.1 billion cf/d). [DOE]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in June 2016: 9,642,000 b/d (June 2015: 9,391,000 b/d). [API]

10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in June 2016: 3,916,000 b/d (June 2015: 3,854,000 b/d). [API]

11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in June 2016 was 417–second lowest count on record (all-time high of 4,530 announced November 1981; record low of 438 announced June 2016). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
