1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in May 2016: 19,705,000 b/d (May 2015: 19,117,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in May 2016: 10,062,000 barrels per day (May 2015: 9,470,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in May 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 51.1 percent (May 2015: 49.5 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in March 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 36.1 percent (March 2015: 26.7 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for May 2016: \$43.21 per barrel. (May 2015: \$62.16 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in April 2016 for a barrel of crude oil: \$37.42 per barrel. (April 2015: \$53.51 per barrel) [DOE]
