

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE - FEBRUARY 2016 release

- 1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in February 2016: 19,783,000 b/d (February 2015: 19,396,000 b/d). [API]
- 2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in February 2016: 9,866,000 barrels per day (February 2015: 9,243,000 b/d). [API]
- 3. Total imports in February 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 49.9 percent (February 2015: 47.7 percent). [API]
- 4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in December 2015 as a percentage of total imports: 38.9 percent (December 2014: 28.7 percent). [DOE]
- 5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for February 2016: \$28.72 per barrel. (February 2015: \$54.06 per barrel). [OPEC]
- 6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in January 2016 for a barrel of crude oil: \$30.83 per barrel. (January 2015: \$47.75 per barrel) [DOE]
- 7. U.S. crude oil production in February 2016: 9,110,000 b/d (of which 549,000 b/d was Alaskan) (February 2015: 9,451,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in February 2016: 3,413,000 b/d (February 2015: 3,100,000 b/d). [API]
- 8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in December 2015: 78.7 billion cubic feet per day (December 2014: 78.0 billion cf/d). [DOE]
- 9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in February 2016: 9,102,000 b/d (February 2015: 8,650,000 b/d). [API]
- 10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in February 2016: 3,765,000 b/d (February 2015: 4,535,000 b/d). [API]
