1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2017: 20,675,000 b/d (July 2016: 19,712,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in July 2017: 9,857,000 barrels per day (July 2016: 10,507,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in July 2017 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 47.7 percent (July 2016: 53.3 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in May 2017 as a percentage of total imports: 43.2 percent (May 2016: 42.5 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for July 2017: \$46.93 per barrel (July 2016: \$42.68 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in June 2017 for a barrel of crude oil: \$45.18 per barrel (June 2016: \$45.96 per barrel). [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in July 2017: 9,422,000 b/d (of which 411,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2016: 8,674,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2017: 3,665,000 b/d (July 2016: 3,573,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in May 2017: 77.3 billion cubic feet per day (May 2016: 77.8 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in July 2017: 9,692,000 b/d (July 2016: 9,597,000 b/d). [API]
10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in July 2017: 4,104,000 b/d (July 2016: 3,578,000 b/d). [API]
