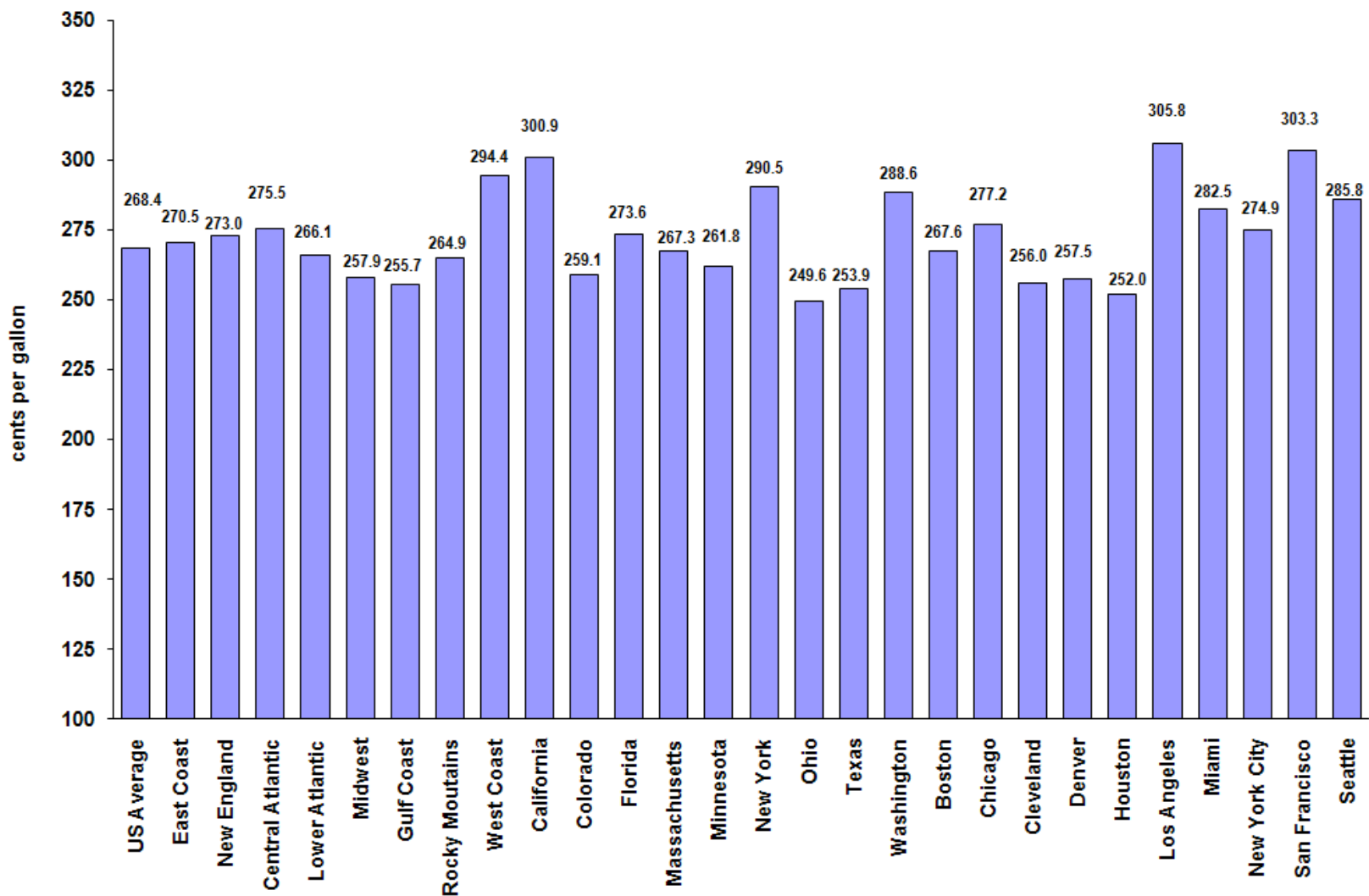
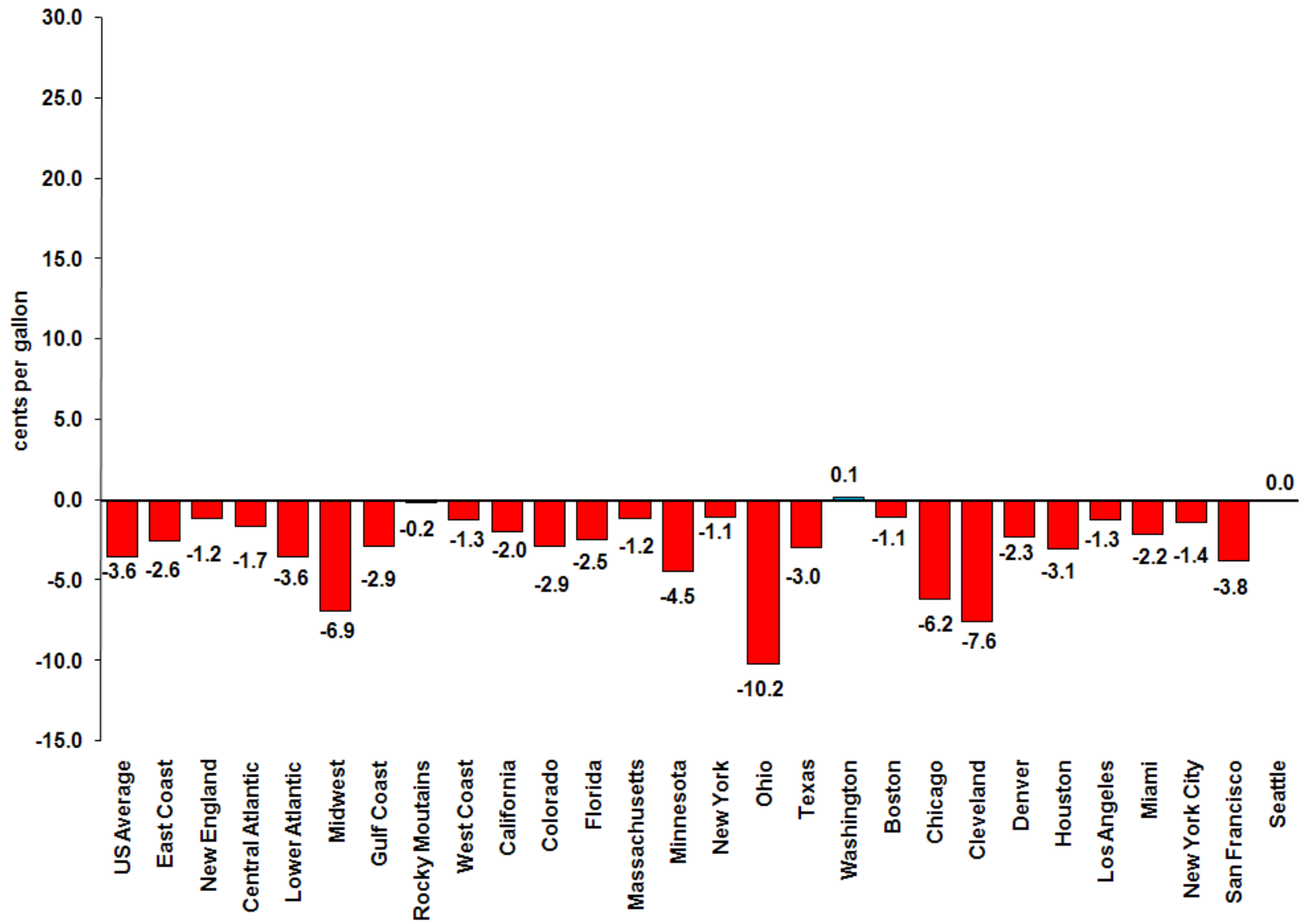


The Average Price of Gasoline (All Grades and Formulations) November 16, 2009



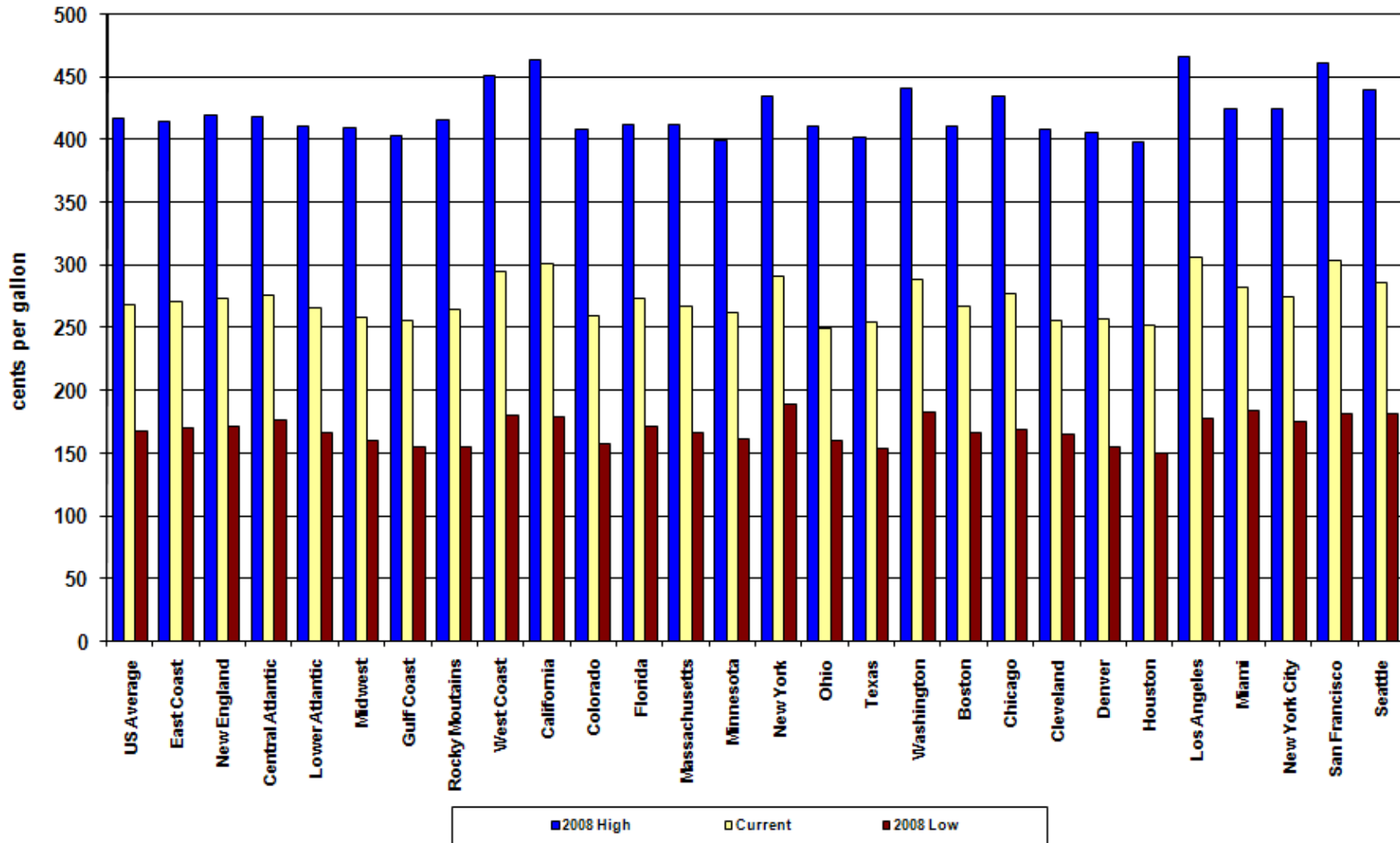

Weekly Change in Gasoline Prices, November 09- November 16, 2009



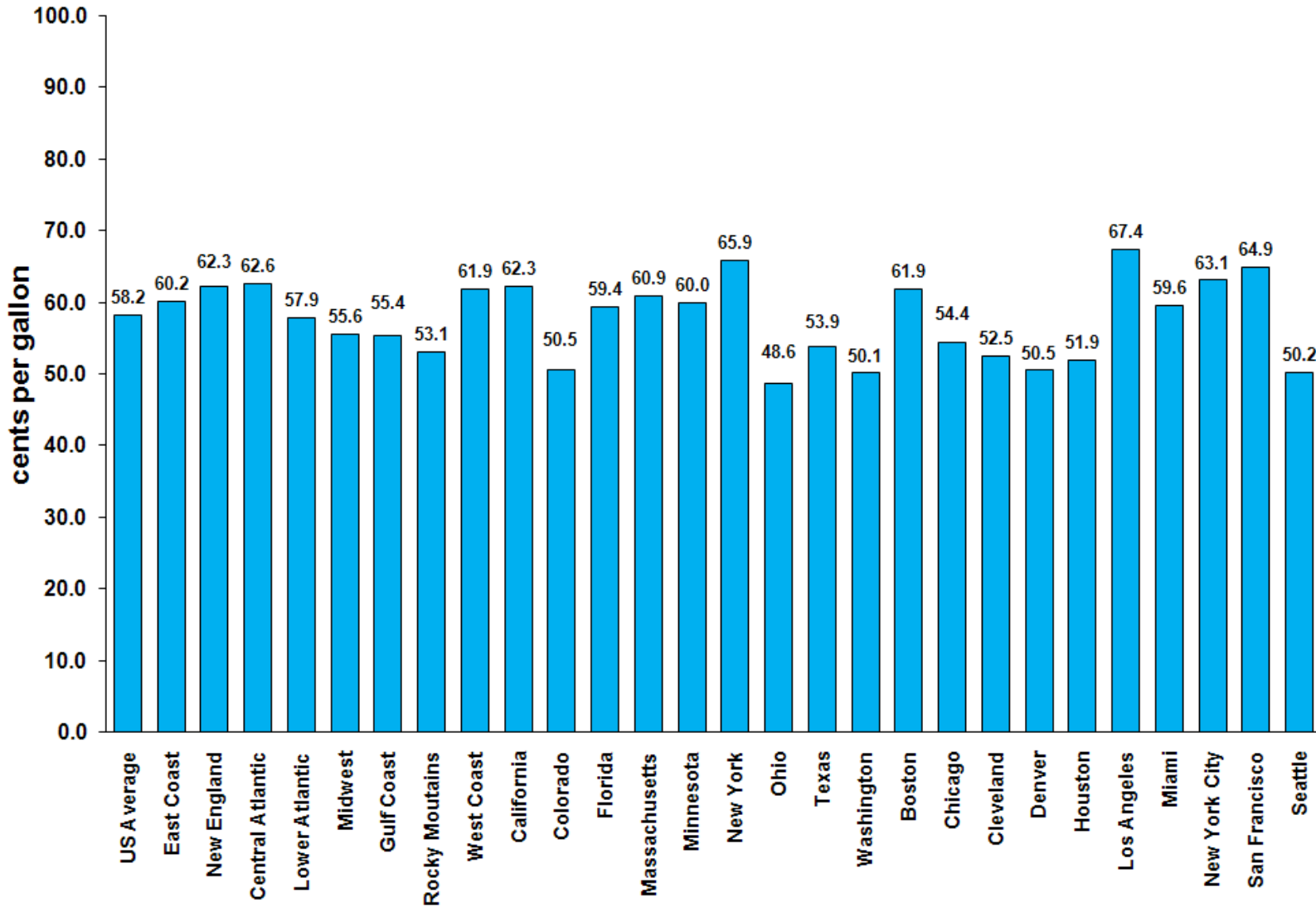

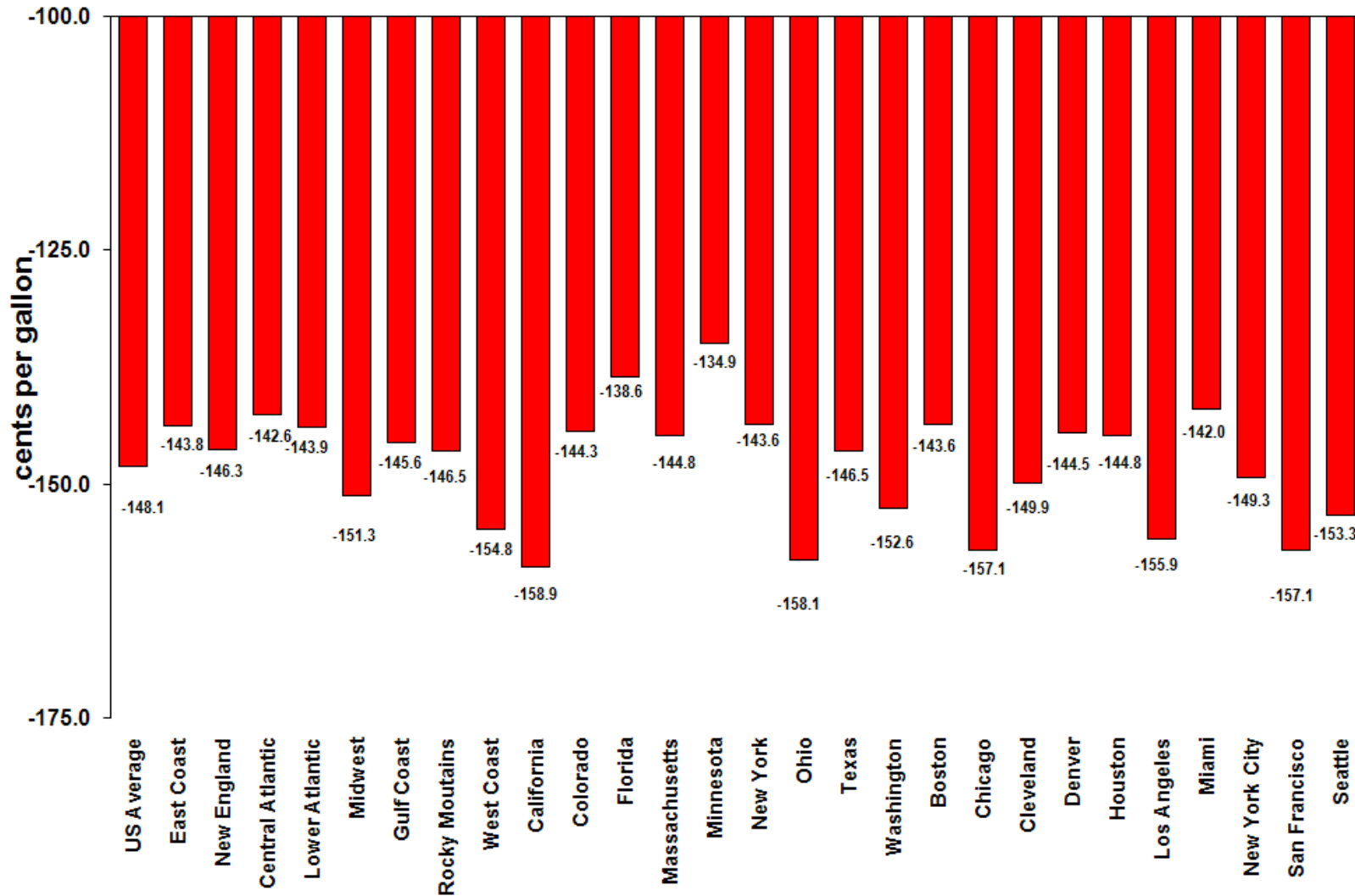
Change in Gasoline Prices 2009: April 27 - November 16

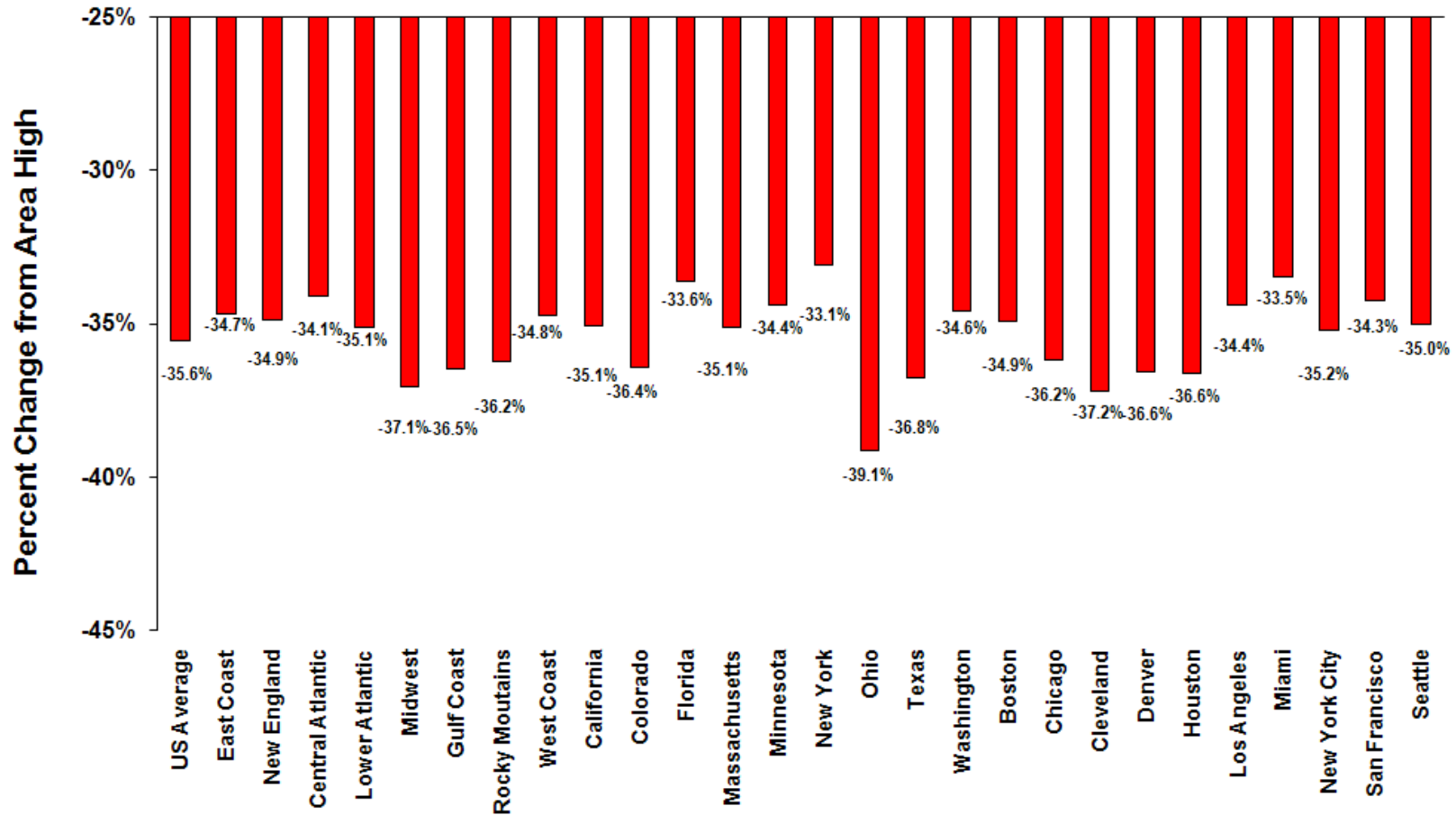
Change in Gasoline Prices Since July 7, 2008
