

TES Examination Information

1. The TES examination consists of 120 multiple-choice questions. The examination is administered by the Professional Examination Service (PES). The total length of the examination is 4 hours and is a closed book examination.
2. If you pass the examination, and all sections of your application are complete, you will be certified and receive a wallet card and a certificate approximately 3 months after the examination date.
3. API grants each candidate three consecutive attempts during a 12-month period to sit and pass the test, beginning with the candidate's first scheduled exam administration. If you fail the examination on your first attempt, you may retake it twice. If you do not show up to take the test it will still count as an official attempt.
4. If you do not pass the examination on the first attempt, you must submit a \$150.00 reschedule fee each time you reschedule. If the candidate is unsuccessful on the third attempt a new application must be submitted with a new full application fee.
5. Examination results will be sent by our examination service to your e-mail address approximately 8 weeks after the exam date.

What to Bring to the Exam

- No. 2 pencils
- A non-programmable calculator (a calculator with only simple functions)
- Your examination site confirmation letter
- A government issued photo ID (i.e., driver's license, passport)
