

Resolution 2011-505

A RESOLUTION SHOWING WOODS CROSS CITY'S APPRECIATION TO J. MICHAEL REDD AND ABS CONSULTING FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE EFFORTS IN RESTORING THE TRUST AND CONFIDENCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AND CITIZENS OF WOODS CROSS IN THE SAFETY PERFORMANCE OF THE SILVER EAGLE REFINERY.

WHEREAS: There was an explosion on November 4, 2009 at the Silver Eagle Refinery which severely damaged the trust and confidence of the City Council and citizens of Woods Cross City in the ability of the refinery to conduct safe operations at the facility.

WHEREAS: Silver Eagle Refinery immediately after the explosion employed J. Michael Redd to help build the trust and confidence of the City in the refinery's ability to conduct safe operations at the facility.

WHEREAS: J. Michael Redd with the help of ABS Consulting has been successful in restoring the community's trust and confidence in the Silver Eagle Refinery's commitment to safety.

WHEREAS: Part of restoring this trust and confidence a quarterly safety scorecard introduced by ABS Consulting was developed and agreed upon by the City and Silver Eagle Refining.

WHEREAS: Silver Eagle used the concepts presented in the American Petroleum Institute's *Recommended Practice 754 - Process Safety Performance Indicators for the Refining* to develop a quarterly safety scorecard for the City and its residents, which helped restore this trust and confidence in Silver Eagle Refining.

WHEREAS: It is a desire of the City and the Refinery that the scorecard will continue to build trust and confidence between the City and the refinery into the future.

WHEREAS: J. Michael Redd is now leaving Silver Eagle Refining to pursue other interests and the City desires to thank him for his efforts.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Woods Cross City Council would like to show its appreciation to J. Michael Redd and ABS Consulting for the work that has been done over the past year in restoring the trust and confidence between Woods Cross City and Silver Eagle Refinery.
