1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in February 2014: 18,538,000 b/d (February 2013: 18,659,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in February 2014: 9,023,000 barrels per day (February 2013: 9,235,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in February 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 48.7 percent (February 2013: 49.5 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in December 2013 as a percentage of total imports: 43.3 percent (December 2012: 29.0 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for February 2014: \$105.38 per barrel. (February 2013: \$112.75 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in January 2014 for a barrel of crude oil: \$93.21 per barrel. (January 2013: \$100.78 per barrel) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in February 2014: 8,022,000 b/d (of which 533,000 b/d was Alaskan) (February 2013: 7,133,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in February 2014: 2,717,000 b/d (February 2013: 2,453,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in December 2013: 71.2 billion cubic feet per day (December 2012: 69.5 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in February 2014: 8,397,000 b/d (February 2013: 8,412,000 b/d). [API]
10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in February 2014: 3,833,000 b/d (February 2013: 3,975,000 b/d). [API]
