## Monday, June 26, 2017 – Lougheed House Tour and Lunch

Lougheed House is a hub of cultural happenings and programs, and in the heart of Calgary's vibrant and hip Beltline community. It is a National and Provincial Historic Site and Museum located on the original 2.8 acres. Lougheed offers spectacular flower and vegetable gardens and indoor, self-guided and audio tours, historic interpreters (if booked in advance), and year round revolving exhibits, concerts, and happenings produced in partnership with cultural collaborators. Lougheed House, also known as Beaulieu, was home to Senator James Alexander Lougheed, Lady Isabella Hardistry Lougheed, their six children, and staff. This grand, sandstone prairie mansion was built in 1891 and enlarged in 1907; the impressive scale and the high quality of the design, materials and interior furnishings of the house reflected the wealth and prestige of the Lougheeds. This 14,000 square-foot, sandstone mansion remains one of the finest residences in Canada's Northwest, and was the political and social hub of fast-growing Calgary until 1938.

## Tuesday, June 27, 2017 - Day Trip to Banff

Banff is a resort town in the province of Alberta, located within Banff National Park. The peaks of Mt. Rundle and Mt. Cascade, part of the Rocky Mountains, dominate its skyline. On Banff Avenue, the main thoroughfare, boutiques and restaurants mix with château-style hotels and souvenir shops. The surrounding 6,500 square kilometres of parkland are home to wildlife including elk and grizzly bears.
