PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – JUNE 2006

1. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in May 2006: 14,331,000 barrels per day (May 2005: 13,495,000 b/d). [API]
2. Total imports in May 2006 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 71.8 percent (May 2005: 67.0 percent). [API]
3. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in March 2006 as a percentage of total imports: 16.6 percent (Mar. 2005: 20.5 percent). [DOE]
4. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil on June 2, 2006: \$65.11. [DOE]
5. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in March 2006 for a barrel of crude oil: \$55.84. [DOE]
6. U.S. crude oil production in May 2006: 5,124,000 b/d (of which 805,000 b/d was Alaskan) (May 2005: 5,457,000 b/d). U.S. natural gas liquids production in May 2006: 1,680,000 b/d (May 2005: 1,842,000 b/d). [API]
7. U.S. marketed natural gas production in February 2006: 52.5 billion cubic feet per day (Feb. 2005: 54.7 billion cf/d). [DOE]
8. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in May 2006: 8,956,000 b/d (May 2005: 9,257,000 b/d). [API]
