

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – April 2010

1. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in March 2010: 11,202,000 barrels per day (March 2009: 12,253,000 b/d). [API]
2. Total imports in March 2010 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 57.9 percent (March 2009: 65.6 percent). [API]
3. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in January 2010 as a percentage of total imports: 13.8 percent (January 2009: 16.8 percent). [DOE]
4. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for the week ending April 2, 2010: \$78.90 [DOE]
5. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in February 2010 for a barrel of crude oil: \$76.65. [DOE]
6. U.S. crude oil production in March 2010: 5,532,000 b/d (of which 688,000 b/d was Alaskan) (March 2009: 5,472,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in March 2010: 1,849,000 b/d (March 2009: 1,850,000 b/d). [API]
7. U.S. marketed natural gas production in January 2010: 61.0 billion cubic feet per day (January 2009: 60.4 billion cf/d). [DOE]
8. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in March 2010: 9,200,000 b/d (March 2009: 8,866,000 b/d). [API]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in March 2010: 3,703,000 b/d (March 2009: 3,732,000 b/d). [API]
10. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in March 2010: 19,333,000 b/d (March 2009: 18,672,000 b/d). [API]
11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. as of April 9, 2010: 1,476 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). (2009 average: 1,086) [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]

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
