

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – May 2010

1. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in April 2010: 11,630,000 barrels per day (April 2009: 11,843,000 b/d). [API]
2. Total imports in April 2010 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 61.3 percent (April 2009: 64.1 percent). [API]
3. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in February 2010 as a percentage of total imports: 14.9 percent (February 2009: 16.2 percent). [DOE]
4. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for the week ending April 30, 2010: \$84.28 [DOE]
5. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in March 2010 for a barrel of crude oil: \$79.85. [DOE]
6. U.S. crude oil production in April 2010: 5,511,000 b/d (of which 654,000 b/d was Alaskan) (April 2009: 5,290,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in April 2010: 1,940,000 b/d (April 2009: 1,851,000 b/d). [API]
7. U.S. marketed natural gas production in February 2010: 61.3 billion cubic feet per day (February 2009: 60.9 billion cf/d). [DOE]
8. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in April 2010: 9,147,000 b/d (April 2009: 8,948,000 b/d). [API]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in April 2010: 3,692,000 b/d (April 2009: 3,460,000 b/d). [API]
10. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in April 2010: 18,971,000 b/d (April 2009: 18,471,000 b/d). [API]
11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. as of May 14, 2010: 1,506 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). (2009 average: 1,086) [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
