

## **PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – July 2011 release**

1. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in June 2011: 11,108,000 barrels per day (June 2010: 12,339,000 b/d). [API]
2. Total imports in June 2011 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 56.5 percent (June 2010: 64.0 percent). [API]
3. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in April 2011 as a percentage of total imports: 19.3 percent (April 2010: 16.2 percent). [DOE]
4. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for June 2011: \$109.53. [DOE]
5. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in April 2011 for a barrel of crude oil: \$112.61. [DOE]
6. U.S. crude oil production in June 2011: 5,358,000 b/d (of which 581,000 b/d was Alaskan) (June 2010: 5,465,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in June 2011: 2,082,000 b/d (June 2010: 1,985,000 b/d). [API]
7. U.S. marketed natural gas production in April 2011: 65.78 billion cubic feet per day (April 2010: 61.55 billion cf/d). [DOE]
8. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in June 2011: 9,285,000 b/d (June 2010: 9,284,000 b/d). [API]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in June 2011: 4,030,000 b/d (June 2010: 3,759,000 b/d). [API]

10. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in June 2011: 19,652,000 b/d (June 2010: 19,291,000 b/d). [API]
