

## **PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – September 2011 release**

1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in August 2011: 19,728,000 b/d (August 2010: 19,662,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in August 2011: 10,999,000 barrels per day (August 2010: 12,356,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in August 2011 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 55.8 percent (August 2010: 62.8 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in June 2011 as a percentage of total imports: 22.1 percent (June 2010: 19.4 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for August 2011: \$86.34. [DOE]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in July 2011 for a barrel of crude oil: \$103.88. [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in August 2011: 5,140,000 b/d (of which 549,000 b/d was Alaskan) (August 2010: 5,440,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in August 2011: 2,185,000 b/d (August 2010: 2,071,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in June 2011: 65.98 billion cubic feet per day (June 2010: 60.65 billion cf/d). [DOE]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in August 2011: 9,133,000 b/d (August 2010: 9,255,000 b/d). [API]

10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in August 2011: 4,245,000 b/d (August 2010: 3,830,000 b/d). [API]
