1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2012: 18,062,000 b/d (July 2011: 18,555,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in July 2012: 10,426,000 barrels per day (July 2011: 11,534,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in July 2012 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 57.7 percent (July 2011: 62.2 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in May 2012 as a percentage of total imports: 32.2 percent (May 2011: 20.0 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for July 2012: \$99.55 per barrel. [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in June 2012 for a barrel of crude oil: \$92.12 per barrel. [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in July 2012: 6,225,000 b/d (of which 439,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2011: 5,480,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2012: 2,376,000 b/d (July 2011: 2,193,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in May 2012: 68.9 billion cubic feet per day (May 2011: 66.0 billion cf/d). [DOE]

9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in July 2012: 8,624,000 b/d (July 2011: 8,960,000 b/d). [API]
