1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2013: 18,925,000 b/d (July 2012: 18,601,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in July 2013: 9,719,000 barrels per day (July 2012: 10,748,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in July 2013 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 51.4 percent (July 2012: 58.8 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in May 2013 as a percentage of total imports: 32.4 percent (May 2012: 32.2 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for July 2013: \$104.45 per barrel. (July 2012: \$99.55 [OPEC])
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in June 2013 for a barrel of crude oil: \$99.86 per barrel. (June 2012: \$91.96) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in July 2013: 7,498,000 b/d (of which 511,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2012: 6,386,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2013: 2,480,000 b/d (July 2012: 2,323,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in May 2013: 69.7 billion cubic feet per day (May 2012: 69.0 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in July 2013: 9,016,000 b/d (July 2012: 8,819,000 b/d). [API]
10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in July 2013: 3,835,000 b/d (July 2012: 3,552,000 b/d). [API]
