

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – April 2013 release

1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in April 2013: 18,393,000 b/d (April 2012: 18,330,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in April 2013: 9,955,000 barrels per day (April 2012: 10,634,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in April 2013 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 54.1 percent (April 2012: 58.0 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in February 2013 as a percentage of total imports: 30.5 percent (February 2012: 25.9 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for April 2013: \$101.05 per barrel. (April 2012: \$118.18) [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in March 2013 for a barrel of crude oil: \$98.59 per barrel. (March 2012: \$110.92) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in April 2013: 7,264,000 b/d (of which 556,000 b/d was Alaskan) (April 2012: 6,269,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in April 2013: 2,409,000 b/d (April 2012: 2,382,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in February 2013: 69.7 billion cubic feet per day (February 2012: 68.6 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in April 2013: 8,472,000 b/d (April 2012: 8,818,000 b/d). [API]
10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in April 2013: 3,757,000 b/d (April 2012: 3,704,000 b/d). [API]
11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in April 2013: 1,755, down from March 2013 at 1,756 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
