

Do you support or oppose increased production of domestic oil and natural gas resources located here in the U.S.?









Most voters feel that it is important to produce more oil and natural gas here at home.















How important is energy when it comes to the issues the federal government should be focusing on?







Do you think the federal government does enough to encourage the development of oil and natural gas resources right here in the U.S.?







Looking ahead to the election in November, how much will your vote be influenced by a politician's stand on energy and America's energy security?







If a candidate supports offshore drilling and producing more oil and natural gas from here in the U.S., would you be more or less likely to support that candidate?








































