1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in August 2014: 19,322,000 b/d (August 2013: 19,125,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in August 2014: 9,208,000 barrels per day (August 2013: 10,249,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in August 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 47.7 percent (August 2013: 53.6 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in June 2014 as a percentage of total imports: 41.3 percent (June 2013: 30.0 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for August 2014: \$100.75 per barrel. (August 2013: \$107.52 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in July 2014 for a barrel of crude oil: \$99.48 per barrel. (July 2013: \$103.85 per barrel) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in August 2014: 8,612,000 b/d (of which 412,000 b/d was Alaskan) (August 2013: 7,453,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in August 2014: 3,085,000 b/d (August 2013: 2,715,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in June 2014: 74.5 billion cubic feet per day (June 2013: 69.9 billion cf/d). [DOE]
