1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in November 2016: 19,573,000 b/d (November 2015: 19,144,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in November 2016: 10,352,000 barrels per day (November 2015: 9,151,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in November 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 52.9 percent (November 2015: 47.8 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in September 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 39.2 percent (September 2015: 30.4 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for November 2016: \$43.22 per barrel (November 2015: \$40.50 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in October 2016 for a barrel of crude oil: \$46.23 per barrel. (October 2015: \$44.77 per barrel) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in November 2016: 8,698,000 b/d (of which 566,000 b/d was Alaskan) (November 2015: 9,304,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in November 2016: 3,464,000 b/d (November 2015: 3,498,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in September 2016: 76.9 billion cubic feet per day (September 2015: 79.7 billion cf/d). [DOE]
