1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in April 2016: 19,725,000 b/d (April 2015: 19,037,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in April 2016: 9,930,000 barrels per day (April 2015: 9,307,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in April 2016 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 50.3 percent (April 2015: 48.9 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in February 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 30.6 percent (February 2015: 31.2 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for April 2016: \$37.86 per barrel. (April 2015: \$57.30 per barrel). [OPEC]
