

■ Very strong ■ Somewhat strong ■ Somewhat weak ■ Very weak ■ Don't Know/Refused











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## **Majority Of Voters Believe State Is On Wrong Track**

Would you say that things in Pennsylvania are going in the right direction or have they gotten off on the wrong track?





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
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### Half Of Voters Think Electricity Prices Are Too High

When it comes to electricity prices here in Pennsylvania, do you think they are too high, too low or about right?




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


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
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# Voters Agree That Electricity Market Should Be Based On Marketplace, Not Special Treatment For One Corporation

Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: The electricity market in Pennsylvania should be based on the marketplace, and not on particular corporations the government decides to grant money to.




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
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# 84% Of Voters Oppose Legislation Charging Customers A Special Fee To Fund Exelon's Nuclear Plants


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
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# Voters Also Agree That Consumers Should Not Have To Pay Special Fee To Bailout Exelon's Nuclear Plants

Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: Pennsylvania consumers should not have to pay a special fee to bailout Exelon's nuclear power plants.




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
