## Distinguished Award Threshold For 2015 Award Year

To be eligible to apply for the API Pipeline Distinguished Environmental and Safety Award, a company's performance must fall within the top quartile for industry performance in **all of the following metrics**:

- Number of spills per thousand miles
- Volume of spills per billion barrel-miles
- Combined employee and contractor TRIR

The top quartile performance generally will be based on a 3-yr rolling average (2012 to 2014). The thresholds are reviewed each year by the API Pipeline Environment, Health & Safety Group (EHSG) to determine the trending of the thresholds and ensure the performance requirements for the Distinguished Award are reasonable.

<u>Small Operator</u> — Eligibility for participation as a Small Operator requires a company to satisfy **any two** of the following three criteria:

- Less than 2500 miles of active pipeline
- Less than **50** billion barrel miles transported
- Less than **1,248,000** combined contractor and employee work hours
