

Production Safety Systems (T2) Refresher Supplemental Evaluation Criteria (INSTRUCTOR-LED)

1 Student Course Prerequisites

- 1.1 The training provider shall maintain a procedure for verifying and documenting that students taking a Production Safety Systems (T2) Refresher Course have met the following prerequisites:
 - a. 6 Years offshore (OCS) oilfield experience
 - b. Successful completion of two instructor-led PSST (T2) courses
 - c. Possession of current, valid Production Safety Systems (T2) certification.

2 Course Structure & Content

- 2.1 For Production Safety Systems (T2) Refresher Courses only, the training provider shall ensure that students receive a minimum of four (4) hours instruction before taking the exam.
- 2.2 Course content shall follow the guidelines as outlined in Section 3.1 of API RP T2.

3 Student Evaluations

- 3.1 The training provider shall include in evaluations or practice exercises related to abnormal conditions resulting from process system malfunctions; relevant government regulations; and safety devices as described in API RP T-2, Sections 3.2, 3.3, and 3.4 respectively.
- 3.2 The training provider shall establish and document that the minimum written examination passing score is 90%.
- 3.3 The training provider shall administer a written examination equivalent to the Production Safety Systems (T-2) Basic course with a minimum of one hundred (100) questions. No pre-test shall be administered.
- 3.4 The training provider shall establish and document that written examinations are to be closed book.
- 3.5 The training provider shall establish and document that the minimum hands-on (practical) examination passing score is 100%.



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3.6 The training provider shall establish and maintain a policy stating that students who fail a Production Safety Systems (T-2) Refresher examination cannot be retested. (Failing students must take a Basic Production Safety Systems instructorled course.).

4 Course Administration

4.1 The training provider shall ensure that course completion cards indicate the appropriate type of card for the certified course for which it was issued.
