1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in November 2013: 19,435,000 b/d (November 2012: 18,528,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in November 2013: 9,602,000 barrels per day (November 2012: 10,181,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in November 2013 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 49.4 percent (November 2012: 54.9 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in September 2013 as a percentage of total imports: 33.5 percent (September 2012: 28.0 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for November 2013: \$104.97 per barrel. (November 2012: \$106.86). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in October 2013 for a barrel of crude oil: \$100.23 per barrel. (October 2012: \$100.02) [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in November 2013: 8,010,000 b/d (of which 569,000 b/d was Alaskan) (November 2012: 7,041,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in November 2013: 2,729,000 b/d (November 2012: 2,536,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in September 2013: 70.2 billion cubic feet per day (September 2012: 69.9 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in November 2013: 8,941,000 b/d (November 2012: 8,483,000 b/d). [API]
10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in November 2013: 3,992,000 b/d (November 2012: 3,848,000 b/d). [API]
