

## PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE - January 2013 release

- 1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in January 2013: 17,962,000 b/d (January 2012: 18,280,000 b/d). [API]
- 2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in January 2013: 10,352,000 barrels per day (January 2012: 10,944,000 b/d). [API]
- 3. Total imports in January 2013 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 57.6 percent (January 2012: 59.9 percent). [API]
- 4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports in November 2012 as a percentage of total imports: 31.3 percent (November 2012: 24.3 percent). [DOE]
- 5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for January 2013: \$109.28 per barrel. (January 2012: \$111.76) [OPEC]
- 6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in December 2012 for a barrel of crude oil: \$94.59 per barrel. (December 2011: \$105.69) [DOE]
- 7. U.S. crude oil production in January 2013: 7,011,000 b/d (of which 587,000 b/d was Alaskan) (January 2012: 6,135,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in January 2013: 2,509,000 b/d (January 2012: 2,376,000 b/d). [API]
- 8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in November 2012: 70.4 billion cubic feet per day (November 2011: 69.2 billion cf/d). [DOE]
- 9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in January 2013: 8,384,000 b/d (January 2012: 8,187,000 b/d). [API]
- 10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in January 2013: 3,595,000 b/d (January 2012: 3,823,000 b/d). [API]
- 11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in January 2013: 1,756, down from December 2012 at 1,784 (all-time high of 4,530 announced 12/28/81; record low of 488 announced 4/23/99). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
