1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in November 2014: 19,858,000 b/d (November 2013: 19,491,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in November 2014: 8,898,000 barrels per day (November 2013: 9,385,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in November 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 44.8 percent (November 2013: 48.2 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in September 2014 as a percentage of total imports: 32.0 percent (September 2013: 36.9 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for November 2014: \$75.57 per barrel. (November 2013: \$104.97 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in October 2014 for a barrel of crude oil: \$84.39 per barrel. (October 2013: \$100.41 per barrel) [DOE]
