In virtually every human activity and invention, energy plays an important role: powering, building and improving the quality of everyday life.

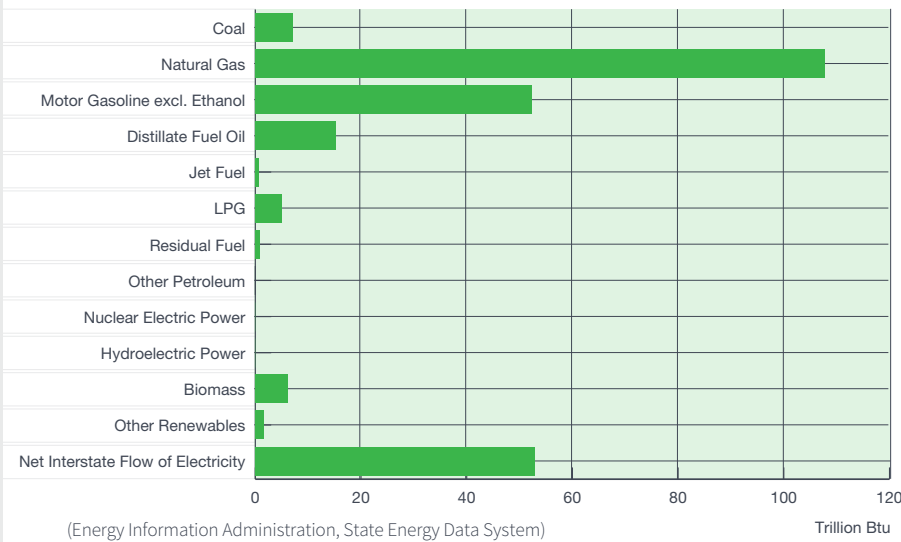

QUICK FACTS:

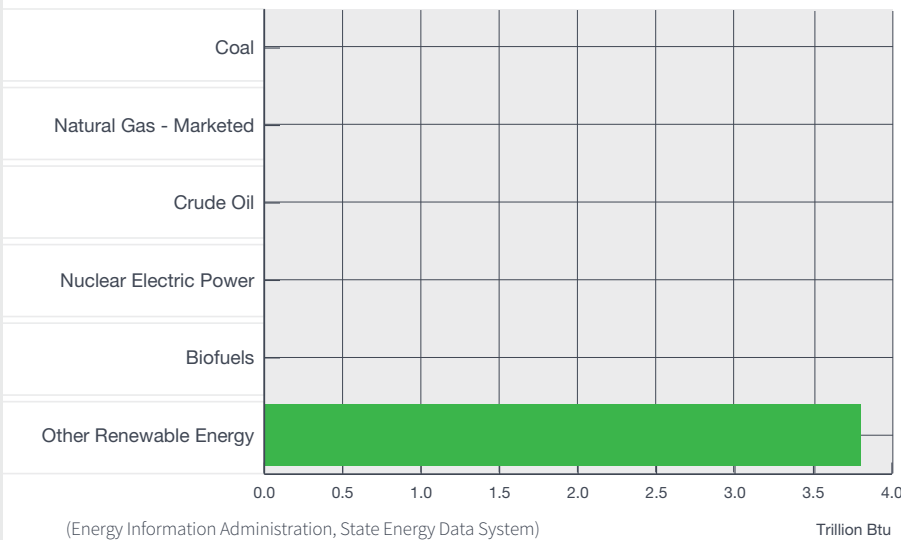
- In 2015, **8.5 million** people vacationed in Delaware, according to state tourism officials, more than a third of them choosing the beach as their top activity.
- Tourism contributed **\$3.1 billion** to state GDP in 2015, about **5 percent** of the total economy.
- Nearly a third of tourists to Delaware in 2015 came from next-door Maryland, more than any other state.
- Delaware is home to more than **39,000 seasonal homes**, most of them near the state's beaches.

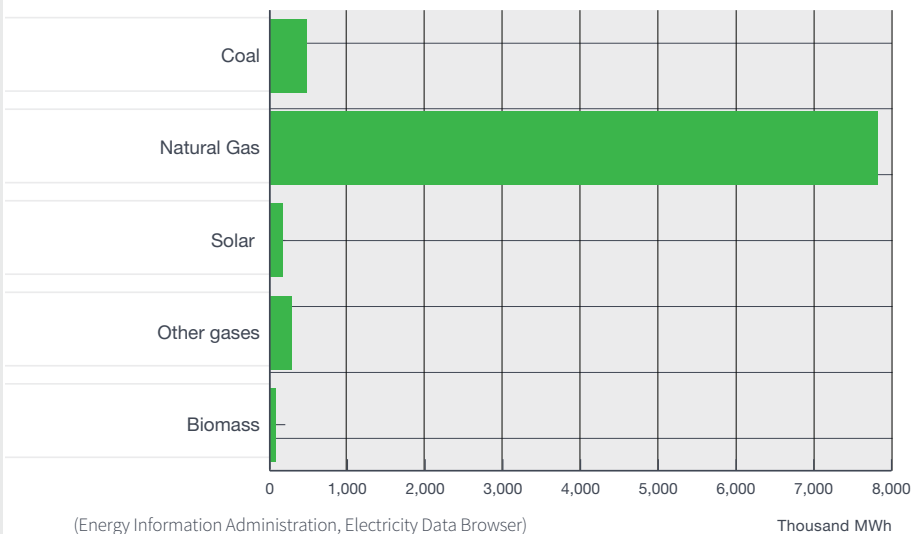
DELAWARE ENERGY CONSUMPTION ESTIMATES 2015
