In virtually every human activity and invention, energy plays an important role: powering, building and improving the quality of everyday life.

Gazing at the stars in the broad expanses of places like Nebraska illustrates this point. To get a really good look at Orion's Belt, the Dippers and other start formations, you have to get away from the city lights. Energy takes you there. Then, from your telescopes and binoculars to tents and sleeping bags, natural gas and oil make that overnight star-gazing trip even better.

QUICK FACTS:

- Because of great galactic distances, we actually see objects as they appeared in the past. Proxima Centauri, the nearest star, is 4.2 light-years away, so we see it as it looked more than four years ago.
- Experts now believe Dutch eyeglass maker Johannes Lippershey, and not Galileo, invented the telescope.
- Telescopes use glass lenses and mirrors to provide magnification.
- Shooting stars aren't stars they're dust particles vaporizing as they fall through our atmosphere.






NEBRASKA ENERGY CONSUMPTION ESTIMATES 2015
