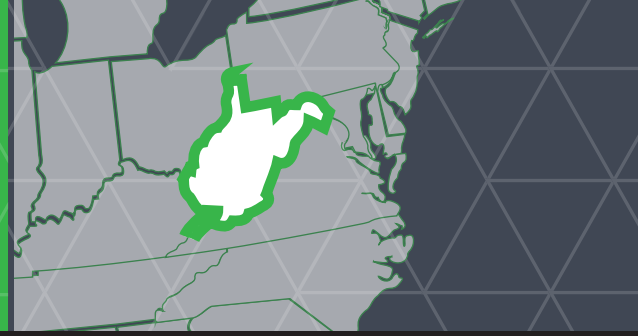


ENERGY IS... WEST VIRGINIA

SLEEPING BAG: Ultra-lightweight nylon shell, nylon taffeta liner, plastic zipper, elastic drawstring — all petroleum-based materials.

SLEEPING PAD:
Nylon envelope, polyurethane foam, plastic valve.

BACKPACK:
Carbon fiber frame for improved flexibility and comfort; light-weight nylon pack.

CANTEEN/WATER BOTTLE:
BPA-free copolyester.

HIKING SHOES:
Polyurethane/nylon (Gore-Tex), synthetic rubber soles.

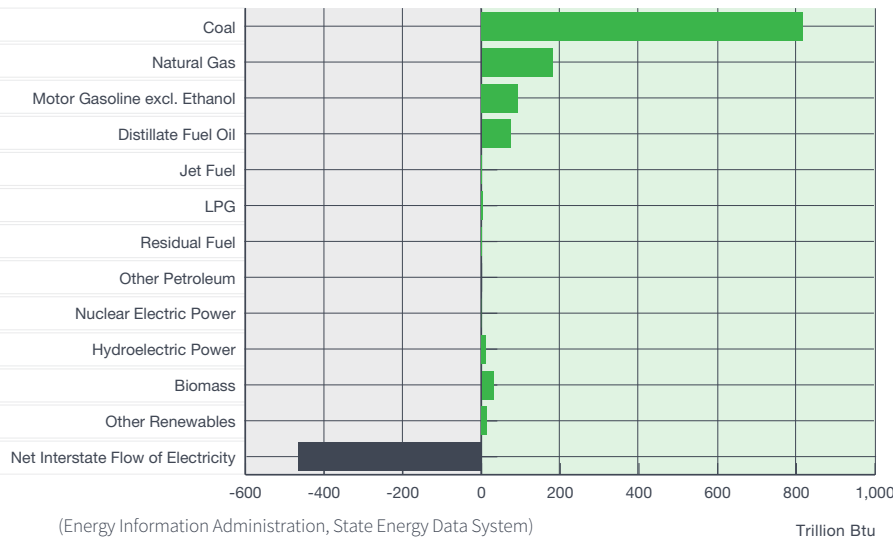
QUICK FACTS:

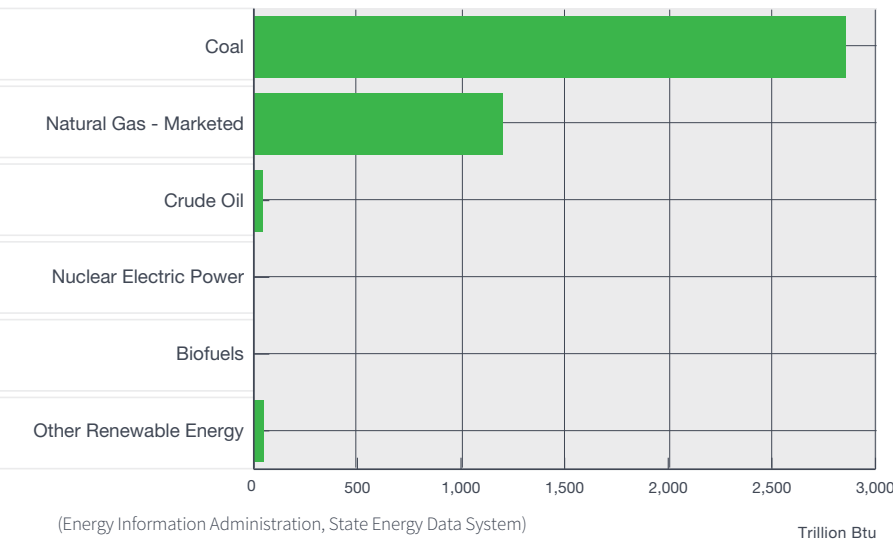

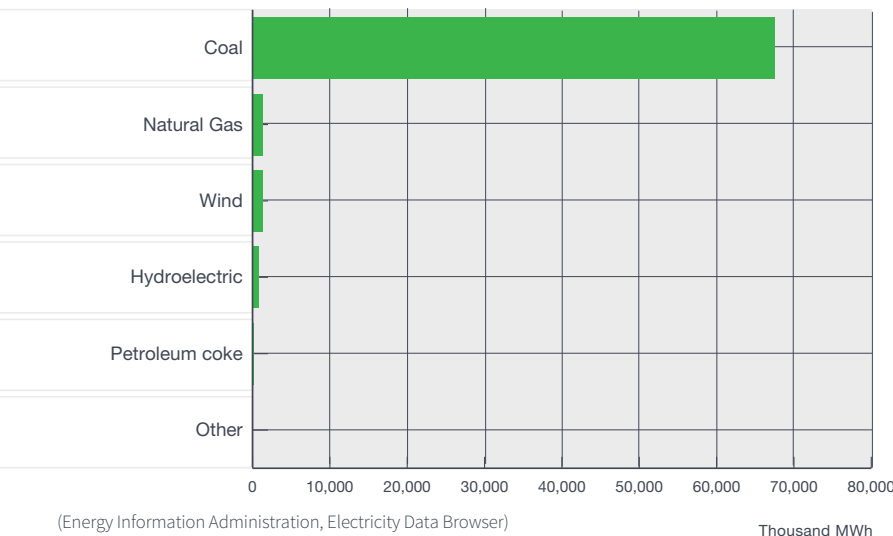
WEST VIRGINIA ENERGY CONSUMPTION ESTIMATES, 2014

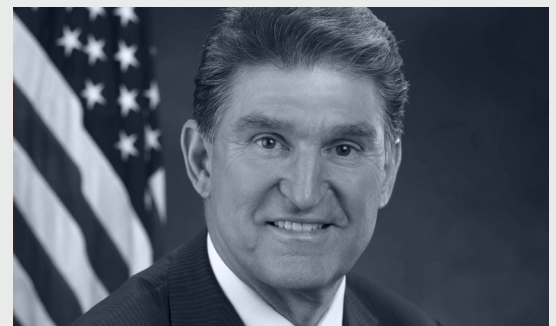
