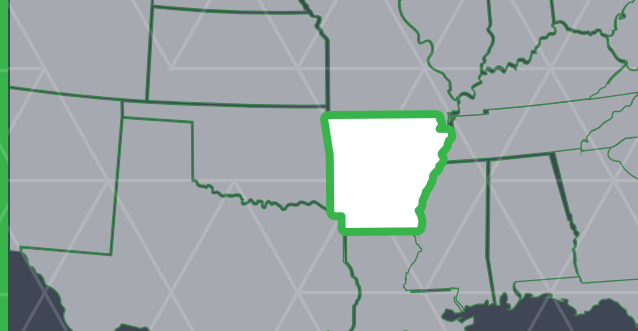

## QUACK, QUACK!

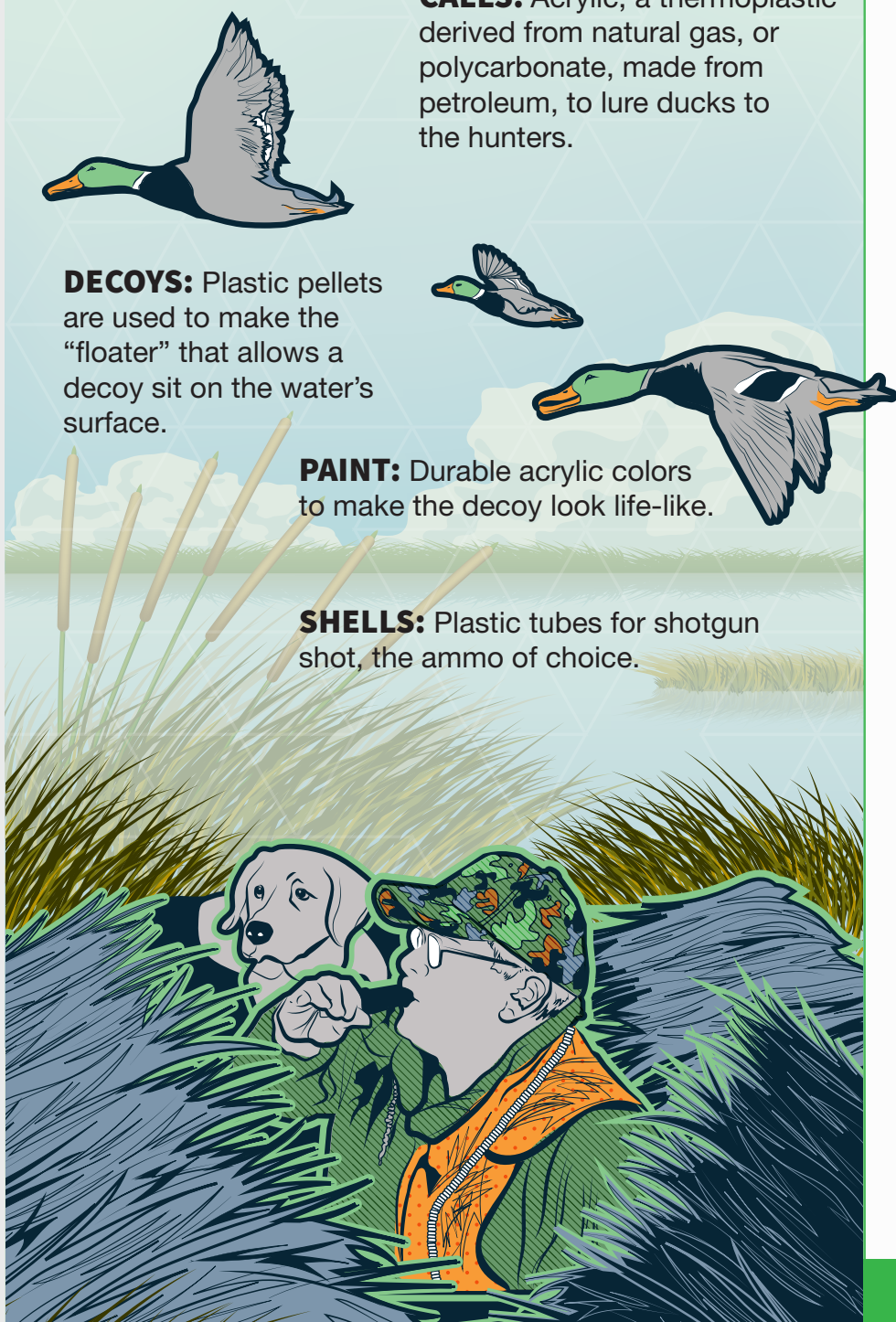
**WADERS:** Neoprene, a petrochemical, provides lightweight durability and thermal insulation.

**CALLS:** Acrylic, a thermoplastic derived from natural gas, or polycarbonate, made from petroleum, to lure ducks to the hunters.

**DECOYS:** Plastic pellets are used to make the “floater” that allows a decoy sit on the water’s surface.

**PAINT:** Durable acrylic colors to make the decoy look life-like.

**SHELLS:** Plastic tubes for shotgun shot, the ammo of choice.

In virtually every human activity and invention, energy plays an important role: powering, building and improving the quality of everyday life.

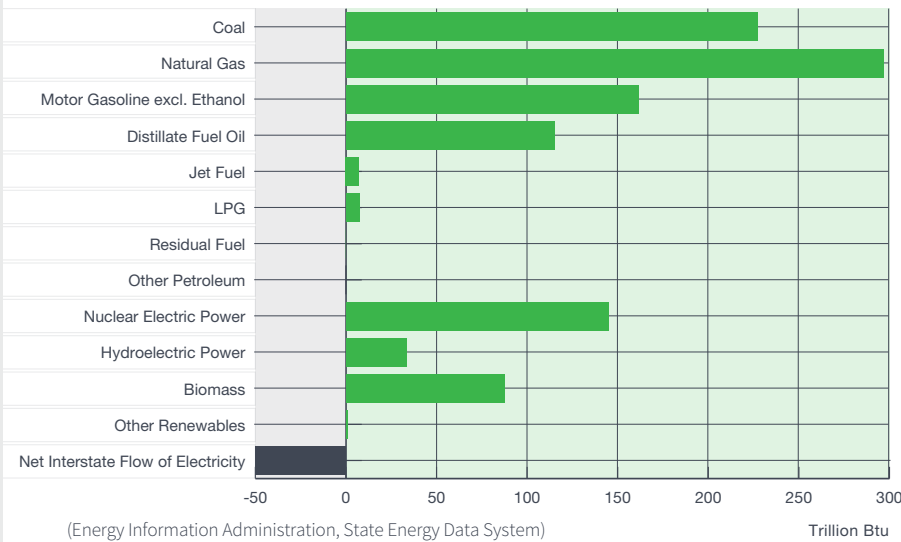

Natural gas and oil play an important role in the attire and equipment needed to make it a good day hunting.

### QUICK FACTS:

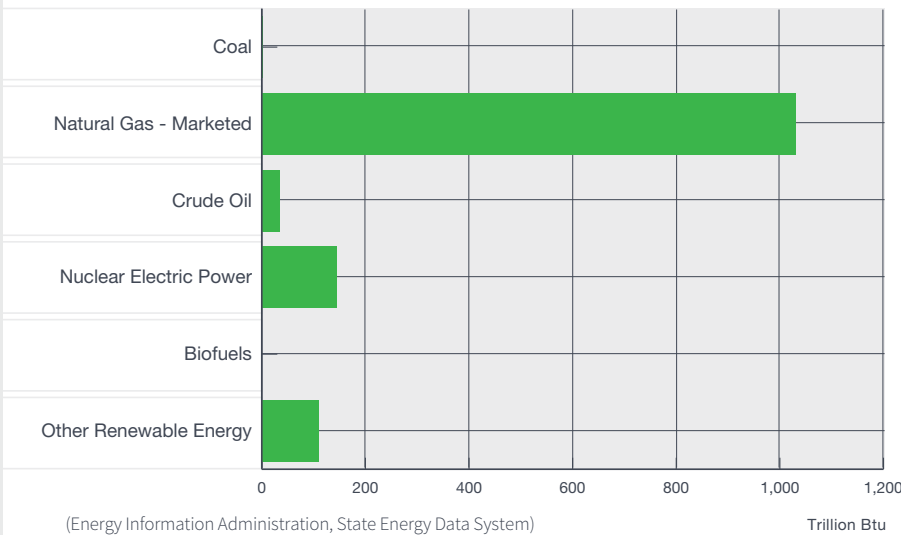
- The number of ducks flying along the Mississippi Flyway between November and January: millions.
- Arkansas has **87,000 duck** hunters.
- The state’s waterfowl season typically allows for six ducks, which may include four mallards, no more than two of which may be hens.
- In the U.S. about **14 million** people 16 and older hunted in the most recent report, **89 percent** of them men.

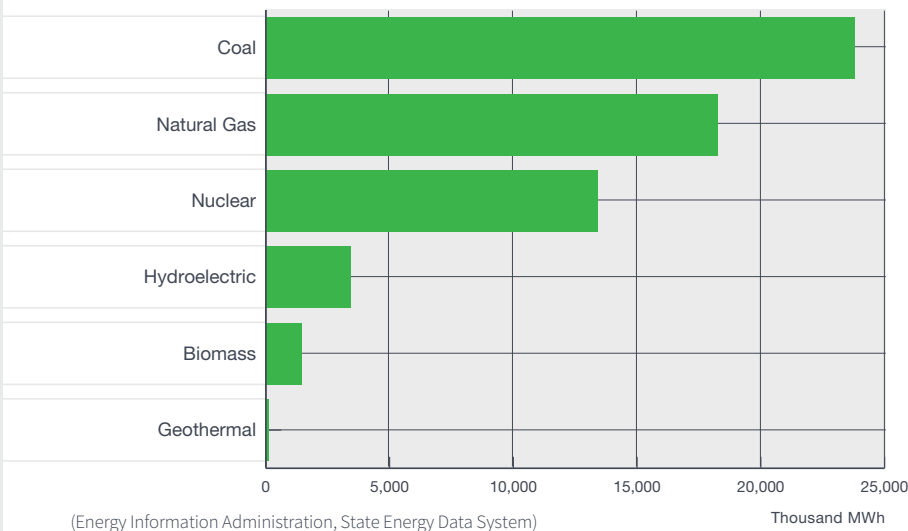
## ARKANSAS ENERGY CONSUMPTION ESTIMATES 2015
