RE: API Monogram Licensing Program Requirements FM-002, Revision 19 Update

Please be advised that the API Monogram Licensing Program Requirements FM-002 has been updated.

- **This agreement revision is effective immediately**

The new edition of the agreement includes the following:

- Added reference to Advisory 10 for the latest fee information and removed specific fee amounts.
- **Part 1, Clause 7; Part 4 Clauses 14 (a), (b), and (c):** Removed the term "primary" as it relates to API's ability to audit the Licensee's contractors.
- **Part 4, Clause 14 (b):** Updated to include the following bolded *"The Licensee understands and agrees that the provisions of this paragraph shall be applicable to the facilities of the Licensee's contractors if API determines, in its sole discretion,"*
- **Part 4 Clause 14(c):** Updated to include wording regarding cooperation from the Licensee in securing any required travel visas.
