

WHAT IS THE API MONOGRAM PROGRAM?

The API Monogram Program recognizes manufacturers that demonstrate the capability to manufacture products that conform to applicable API standards and specifications, driving safety and sustainability across the natural gas and oil industry.

THE MONOGRAM MARK

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The Monogram mark signifies that a licensed manufacturer has successfully undergone a quality audit, including a review of requirements related to the licensed products.



API has verified that the manufacturer has implemented, maintained and continually improved its Quality Management System to meet applicable requirements of API Spec Q1 and the product specifications for which the manufacturer is licensed at the time of the audit.



The manufacturer represents and warrants that, on the date of manufacture, the product conforms to all applicable current editions of specifications, standards and API requirements. The manufacturer has implemented processes and controls to identify and address customer requirements, customer complaints and product issues.

THE API MONOGRAM MARK CAN BE APPLIED TO PRODUCTS THAT ARE

- ☑ Newly manufactured at a facility that is licensed to apply the Monogram to designated products
- Represented as meeting all relevant requirements of the applicable API product specifications, API Spec Q1 and Monogram Program License Agreement
- ☑ Specifically identified in Monogram Licensing Information Forms
- ☑ Identified on the Licensee's Monogram Certificate at the time of application of the API Monogram Mark

THE API MONOGRAM MARK CANNOT BE APPLIED TO PRODUCTS THAT ARE

- ☑ Refurbished, remanufactured or recertified
- Determined as failing to meet API product specification, API Spec Q1 or Monogram Program requirements
- Z Excluded from Monogram Licensing Information Forms
- ☑ Manufactured prior to issuance of the Monogram license

The API Composite List recognizes manufacturers that are eligible to apply the Monogram to products meeting API requirements. Organizations looking to purchase products meeting API specification requirements should consult the globally recognized <u>Composite List</u> before making any purchases.
