1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2014: 19,289,000 b/d (July 2013: 19,046,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in July 2014: 9,056,000 barrels per day (July 2013: 10,243,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in July 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 46.9 percent (July 2013: 53.8 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in May 2014 as a percentage of total imports: 36.4 percent (May 2013: 32.4 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for July 2014: \$105.61 per barrel. (July 2013: \$104.45 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in June 2014 for a barrel of crude oil: \$103.35 per barrel. (June 2013: \$98.67 per barrel) [DOE]
