1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in June 2014: 19,005,000 b/d (June 2013: 18,724,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in June 2014: 9,232,000 barrels per day (June 2013: 9,790,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in June 2014 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 48.6 percent (June 2013: 52.3 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in April 2014 as a percentage of total imports: 40.5 percent (April 2013: 25.6 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for June 2014: \$107.89 per barrel. (June 2013: \$101.03 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in May 2014 for a barrel of crude oil: \$100.66 per barrel. (May 2013: \$100.17 per barrel) [DOE]
