1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in April 2017: 19,597,000 b/d (April 2016: 19,264,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in April 2017: 10,156,000 barrels per day (April 2016: 9,829,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in April 2017 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 51.8 percent (April 2016: 51.0 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in February 2017 as a percentage of total imports: 55.1 percent (February 2016: 30.6 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for April 2017: \$51.34 per barrel (April 2016: \$37.86 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in March 2017 for a barrel of crude oil: \$48.54 per barrel (March 2016: \$33.82 per barrel). [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in April 2017: 9,249,000 b/d (of which 514,000 b/d was Alaskan) (April 2016: 8,947,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in April 2017: 3,450,000 b/d (April 2016: 3,504,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in February 2017: 77.3 billion cubic feet per day (February 2016: 82.3 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in April 2017: 9,271,000 b/d (April 2016: 9,213,000 b/d). [API]
