

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – MAY 2019 RELEASE

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in May 2019: 18,181,000 b/d, up by 2,157,000 b/d in the past year (May 2018: 16,024,000 b/d) [API]
2. Record U.S. crude oil production in May 2019: 12,235,000 b/d (of which 473,000 b/d was Alaskan) (May 2018: 10,464,000 b/d). Record U.S. production of natural gas liquids in May 2019: 4,753,000 b/d (May 2018: 4,321,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in May 2019: 20,057,000 b/d (May 2018: 20,357,000 b/d). [API]
4. Total May petroleum exports: 8,121,000 b/d (May 2018: 7,517,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance fell by 636,000 b/d to 2,075,000 b/d in May 2019 from 2,711,000 b/d in May 2018. [API]
