
PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – August 2021 RELEASE

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in July 2021: 17,902,000 b/d, up by 526,000 b/d compared with July 2020 (July 2020: 17,376,000 b/d) [API]
2. U.S. crude oil production for the month of July: 11,380,000 b/d (of which 390,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2020: 10,956,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2021: 5,401,000 b/d (July 2020: 5,369,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2021: 20,610,000 b/d (July 2020: 18,323,000 b/d). [API]
4. Petroleum exports for the month of July: 8,307,000 b/d (July 2020: 8,412,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance expanded by 1,345,000 b/d to imply July 2021 net imports of 779,000 b/d (July 2020: 566,000 b/d net exports). [API]
