
PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – January 2022 RELEASE

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in December 2021: 18,381,000 b/d, up by 1,147,000 b/d compared with December 2020 (December 2020: 17,234,000 b/d) [API]
2. U.S. crude oil production in December 2021: 11,715,000 b/d (of which 480,000 b/d was Alaskan) (December 2020: 11,084,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in December 2021: 5,554,000 b/d (December 2020: 5,058,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in December 2021: 21,051,000 b/d (December 2020: 18,802,000 b/d). [API]
4. U.S. petroleum exports in December 2021: 7,897,000 b/d (December 2020: 8,924,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance expanded by 1,587,000 b/d to imply December 2021 net imports of 401,000 b/d (December 2020: 1,186,000 b/d net exports). [API]
