
PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – November 2022 RELEASE

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in October 2022: 19,270,000 b/d, up by 756,000 b/d compared with October 2021 (October 2021: 18,514,000 b/d) [API]
2. U.S. crude oil production in October 2022: 12,050,000 b/d (of which 440,000 b/d was Alaskan) (October 2021: 11,569,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in October 2022: 6,130,000 b/d (October 2021: 5,721,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in October 2022: 20,343,000 b/d (October 2021: 20,377,000 b/d). [API]
4. U.S. petroleum exports in October 2022: 10,050,000 b/d (October 2021: 8,226,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance contracted by 1,986,000 b/d to imply October 2022 net exports of 2,076,000 b/d (October 2021: 90,000 b/d net exports). [API]
