RE: New ANAB Accreditation Mark

APIQR's ISO 9001 and ISO 14001 programs are accredited by the ANSI National Accreditation Board (ANAB). As part of the accreditation, registered clients can use the ANAB accreditation mark as specified in the APIQR Registration Program Requirements (available on the [API website](http://api.org)). Note that use of the ANAB accreditation mark by registered facilities is optional.

ANAB recently updated its accreditation mark and is requiring that all certified clients transition to the new symbol. API will be providing a copy of the new mark with your next ISO 9001 and/or ISO 14001 certificate. Once the new symbol has been provided, it shall be the only ANAB mark used by the organization. Any former ANAB accreditation mark shall no longer be used. This includes the removal of the mark from any correspondence, advertising, or promotional materials.

A copy of the ANAB mark can be found on the bottom left corner of your ISO 9001 and/or ISO 14001 certificate. APIQR also provides all relevant marks that can be used by your organization in myCerts under Facility Details > Files.
