RE: API Specification Q1, 10th Edition Effective Date Reminder

The Monogram/APIQR Program would like to remind our licensing and registration clients that API Specification Q1 10th Edition, *Quality Management System Requirements for Organizations Providing Products for the Petroleum and Natural Gas Industry*, will become effective on September 18, 2024.

All organizations must conform to the 10th edition no later than September 18, regardless of when their next API audit is scheduled to occur. During your next audit, API auditors may review records dating back to September 18 to confirm the date of transition.

For organizations that have audits beginning before the week of September 18 and ending on or after September 18, the audit criteria will be API Q1 10th edition to ensure that the organization transitioned by the effective date.
