1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in June 2017: 20,342,000 b/d (June 2016: 19,833,000 b/d). [API]
2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in June 2017: 10,242,000 barrels per day (June 2016: 10,076,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total imports in June 2017 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 50.3 percent (June 2016: 50.8 percent). [API]
4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in April 2017 as a percentage of total imports: 50.0 percent (April 2016: 36.5 percent). [DOE]
5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for June 2017: \$45.21 per barrel (June 2016: \$45.84 per barrel). [OPEC]
6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in May 2017 for a barrel of crude oil: \$48.53 per barrel (May 2016: \$42.88 per barrel). [DOE]
7. U.S. crude oil production in June 2017: 9,335,000 b/d (of which 461,000 b/d was Alaskan) (June 2016: 8,711,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in June 2017: 3,630,000 b/d (June 2016: 3,618,000 b/d). [API]
8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in April 2017: 76.8 billion cubic feet per day (April 2016: 78.0 billion cf/d). [DOE]
9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in June 2017: 9,614,000 b/d (June 2016: 9,664,000 b/d). [API]
