

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – SEPTEMBER 2018 RELEASE

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in September 2018: 16,614,000 b/d, up by 2,190,000 b/d in the past year (September 2017: 14,424,000 b/d) [API]
2. Record U.S. crude oil production in September 2018: 11,042,000 b/d (of which 460,000 b/d was Alaskan) (September 2017: 9,495,000 b/d). Record U.S. production of natural gas liquids in September 2018: 4,334,000 b/d (September 2017: 3,731,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in September 2018: 20,103,000 b/d (September 2017: 19,641,000 b/d). [API]
4. Total September petroleum exports: 7,419,000 b/d (September 2017: 6,289,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance fell by 1,646,000 b/d to 2,890,000 b/d in September 2018 from 3,463,000 b/d in September 2017. [API]
