Monday, October 17, 2016 - Newport Beach Harbor and Bay Area Cruise

Newport Harbor is a semi-artificial harbor that was formed by dredging Newport Bay estuary during the early 1900s. Several artificial islands were built, which are now covered with private homes: Newport Island, Balboa Island, Little Balboa Island, Collins Island, Bay Island, Harbor Island, Lido Isle, and Linda Isle. You will cruise around the Newport Beach Harbor and Bay areas while enjoying lunch. Newport Beach's waterfront homes are amazing and occupied by celebrities, corporation heads, and political figures. This two hour cruise is one you will not soon forget.

Tuesday – October 18, 2016 – Laguna Beach Day Trip

Laguna Beach is a seaside resort city located in southern Orange County, California. It is known for a mild year-round climate, scenic coves, environmental preservation, and an artist community. Historically a territory of <u>Paleo Indians</u>, the <u>Tonga</u> people, and then Mexico, the location became part of the United States following the Mexican–American War. Laguna Beach was settled in the 1870s, officially founded in 1887 and, in 1927, its current government was incorporated as a city. In 1944, the city adopted a council-manager form for its government. The city has remained relatively isolated from urban encroachment by its surrounding hills, limited highway access, and a dedicated greenbelt. The Laguna Beach coastline is protected by 5.88 miles (9.46 km) of state marine reserve and an additional 1.21 miles (1.95 km) of state conservation area.

You will spend the day in this unique little beach town. Laguna Beach is the pristine beauty that she is because there are so many people who care about her everlasting beauty. An art colony from its roots, there are a number of committees that not only look after Laguna's natural loveliness, but help create and place art in public places, from lamppost banner originals by local artists to towering edifices and street corner art just about everywhere you look.

Laguna Beach offers a vast variety of shopping opportunities, and much of what you find is innovated right there in Laguna Beach. Be sure to explore one-of-a-kind retail shops for "made in Laguna" décor, bath salts and oils, jewelry, clothing, purses, hats and much more.
