

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE - FEBRUARY 2017 release

- 1. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in February 2017: 19,697,000 b/d (February 2016: 19,680,000 b/d). [API]
- 2. U.S. petroleum imports (crude & products) in February 2017: 10,384,000 barrels per day (February 2016: 10,020,000 b/d). [API]
- 3. Total imports in February 2017 as a percentage of total domestic petroleum deliveries: 52.7 percent (February 2016: 50.9 percent). [API]
- 4. Persian Gulf petroleum imports (net) in December 2016 as a percentage of total imports: 43.1 percent (December 2015: 38.9 percent). [DOE]
- 5. Average price for a barrel of OPEC crude oil for February 2017: \$53.37 per barrel (February 2016: \$28.72 per barrel). [OPEC]
- 6. Average U.S. refiner acquisition cost in January 2017 for a barrel of crude oil: \$50.68 per barrel (January 2016: \$29.99 per barrel). [DOE]
- 7. U.S. crude oil production in February 2017: 9,028,000 b/d (of which 504,000 b/d was Alaskan) (February 2016: 9,147,000 b/d). U.S. production of natural gas liquids in February 2017: 3,424,000 b/d (February 2016: 3,329,000 b/d). [API]
- 8. U.S. marketed natural gas production in December 2016: 76.1 billion cubic feet per day (December 2015: 78.7 billion cf/d). [DOE]
- 9. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of motor gasoline in February 2017: 8,855,000 b/d (February 2016: 9,206,000 b/d). [API]
- 10. U.S. deliveries from primary storage of distillate fuel oil (home heating and diesel) in February 2017: 3,995,000 b/d (February 2016: 3,959,000 b/d). [API]
- 11. Average active rotary drilling rigs in the U.S. in February 2017 was 744– second lowest February count on record (all-time high of 4,521 announced November 1981; record low of 409 announced May 2016). [Baker Hughes Inc., Houston]
